Using these ideals, we strive to promote sustainability through greenhouse gas and carbon emission reduction, effective waste management strategies, and a stronger approach to a circular economy.







### Beach Road Streetscape.

City of Onkaparinga, Construct Only, \$0.5M





This project comprised construction of four landscape nodes along Beach Road, Christies Beach including demolition works, stormwater infrastructure, electrical and lighting, new kerbing and road reinstatement, footpath extensions, new paved areas, new concrete plinths and seating, new garden beds and street trees, irrigation works, and infrastructure services connections.

The works were delivered in a confined footprint, on a busy urban street, which was challenging. Works were scheduled outside of business hours to minimise the impact on local shops.

### Edwardstown Ambulance Station.

BluBuilt and the Department for Infrastructure and Transport, Construct Only, \$0.15M





Landscaping of the new ambulance station including irrigation system design and construct, earthworks, soil amelioration and topsoiling, composite edging, advanced tree planting, turf installation, and planting and soft landscaping. The rear carpark of the new building was not trafficable, we adopted alternative landscape methods to access the rear garden to complete the works.

By adopting our waste management practices and sustainability targets, this project saved  $1\text{m}^3$  of recyclable materials from landfill and implemented the sustainable use of recycled plastic composite edging.

# Kingston Park Kiosk.

BluBuilt and the City of Holdfast Bay, Construct Only, \$0.05M





The architecturally designed kiosk boasts seating for up to 40 guests indoors and 42 outdoors. Constructed on a culturally significant Kaurna site, we provided a revised landscape design to ensure the area was protected. We undertook demolition and earthworks, irrigation design and construction, soil amelioration and topsoiling, composite edging, corten steel laser cut screen, advanced tree planting, turf installation, planting and softscaping, and external pavements.

Robust traffic management strategies were required to work within the confines of an operational holiday park and highly trafficked shared use path.

### Woodlake Reserve.

City of Charles Sturt, Construct Only, \$0.3M





Local playground and reserve upgrade to include nature play, playground and softfall installation, advanced tree planting, irrigation system, shelters, soft landscaping and planting, pavements and fencing, and lawn reinstatement. As there were a number of tree protection zones, we redesigned the new concrete footpath to weave around the shallow roots, while maintaining compliance with DDA regulations.

By adopting our waste management practices and sustainability targets, this project saved 3m³ of recyclable materials from landfill, used 156t of salvaged materials and implemented the sustainable use of recycled polymer reinforced concrete and salvaged timber seating logs..

# Knox Sports Park Reserve.

BluBuilt and the City of Onkaparinga, Construct Only, \$2.5M





The sports park was designed to provide modern amenities to the southern athletic community. Works included a 1.8ha irrigated oval with megaflow drainage, senior sized soccer field, discus and throwing circles, two-way long jump/triple jump, 400m athletics track, 200m2 storage facility with power, public toilet, 22,000L storage tank and pumping system, inclusive playground, and tree planting & landscaping.

By adopting our waste management practices and sustainability targets, this project saved 1,500m<sup>3</sup> organic materials from landfill, used 500t of salvaged topsoil, and implemented the sustainable use of recycled plastic composite edging.

# McGilp Reserve Upgrade.

BluBuilt and the City of Playford, Construct Only, \$0.7M





We were engaged at the greater McGilp Reserve Upgrade project to undertake the irrigation to oval and entry statement, soil amelioration, mega flow drainage system, soccer pitch extension, including placement of growing medium and laying instant turf, new playspace with multiplay tower and inclusive carousel, rubber surfacing and organic softfall, rock boulder edging and timber log, advanced tree planting, and mulched garden beds and planting.

During the project, we returned 1,733 plant pots to the nursery for reuse, used recycled HDPE materials in the new drainage system, and 126t of recycled materials were used.

# St John Bosco Courtyard.

Catholic Church Endowment Society, Construct Only, \$0.7M





This project, undertaken in an operational primary school, comprised an upgrade of the central courtyard including demolition of the existing courts and pavements, new concrete and paved footpaths, construction of an amphitheatre and arbor, installation of furniture and shade sails, ature play and creek water feature, irrigation system, and garden beds.

This once tired courtyard has been revitalised and transformed into a multi-functional space designed to inspire learning and foster community engagement.

# Ramsey Place Gateway 1.

City of Onkaparinga, Construct Only, \$0.2M





The project comprised construction of entrance improvements to Gateway 1, Ramsay Place. Gateway 1 is an important public pedestrian entrance providing public access to a regional civic centre, Hopgood Theatre, and Colonnades Shopping Centre.

We were engaged to transform the space into a welcoming and aesthetically pleasing entrance, while providing a safer environment and better wayfinding. The works included demolition of signage and fencing, landscape walling and edging, landscaping, fencing and barriers, installation of furniture and fixtures, and texture coating graphic to existing pavement.
